



- Select if you want to apply to a two-year or four-year

5) My Applications tab


The admissions application is split into three sections:

- 3. Essays (if applicable)






Biographical Information

- *Make sure everything with asterisks is filled out




Family Obligations

Parent Information


- Fill out parent information





Senior Courses


 This section is where you will enter all of your senior courses. This is tedious but it is very important to enter correct information.

*Log into SKYWARD to access your courses




Extracurricular Activities

 Make sure to add any community/volunteer services as of date




Talent/Award/Honor

List out talents, awards, and honors granted as of date.






Specific University Questions

Test Options

Freshmen Fee Waiver Request

In order to be eligible for an application fee waiver, US freshman applicants must submit an official fee waiver form after application submission. - · Eligible for ACT or SAT/College Board fee waiver
- · Eligible for federal free/reduced lunch program
- · I am in foster care or homeless
- · I am a ward of the state or an orphan



- The student will then NEED to click the "Submit this application" button to start the submission process.


