

AP Students! Here is an updated AP exam schedule with everything all in one place for you! By now, your AP teachers should have informed you of the change in exam dates and times. All exams will be administered online, and exam formats have changed in order to fit the allotted time for each exam.

**Here is what you need to do:**

1. Make sure you can log into your email you set up on your College Board account. This should be set to a personal email account, those of you that had it set to your PISD email account I had you change that during the Fall semester.
  2. Prior to your scheduled exam time, you will receive your login credentials for the AP exam at the email address you have listed on your College Board account.
  3. If you need to change the email address on your College Board account, you will need to log in and go to your account settings and update your email address.
  4. If you are unable to log into your College Board account, and are unsuccessful at resetting your account, you will need to contact College Board so they can assist you in resetting this login. You can reach College Board at 1-888-225-5427.
  5. If you do not have a working tablet you need to report this ASAP so that we can get this fixed well in advance of the exams. Report this issue at support.pmhsmavs.com (link is also on PMHS homepage).
  6. If you do not have access to internet you also need to report this to your AP teacher and Ms. Duke.
